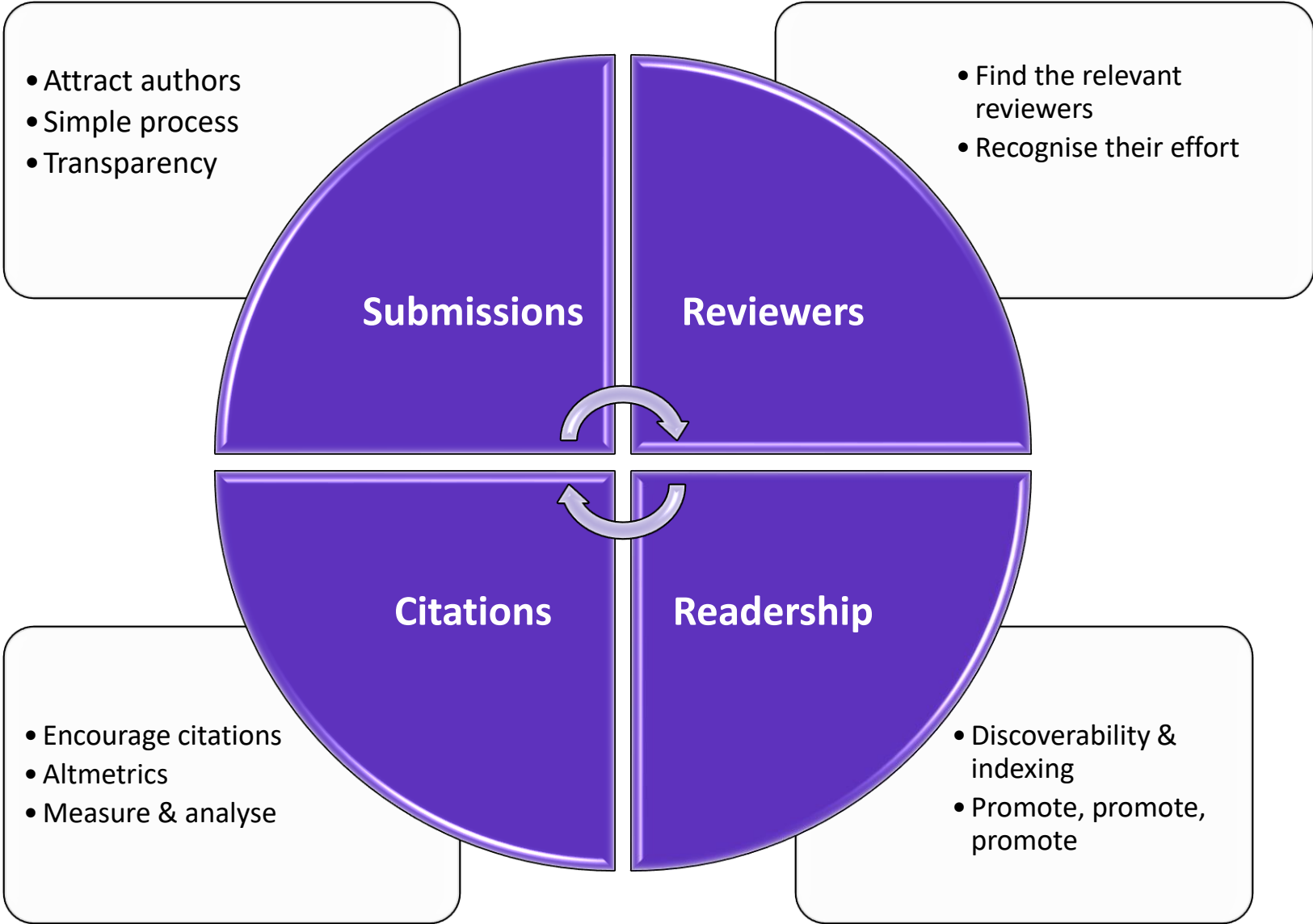

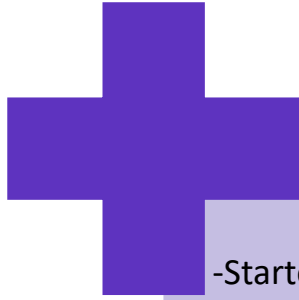


Journal Success

- **Submitted for evaluation** to Scopus and Web of Science

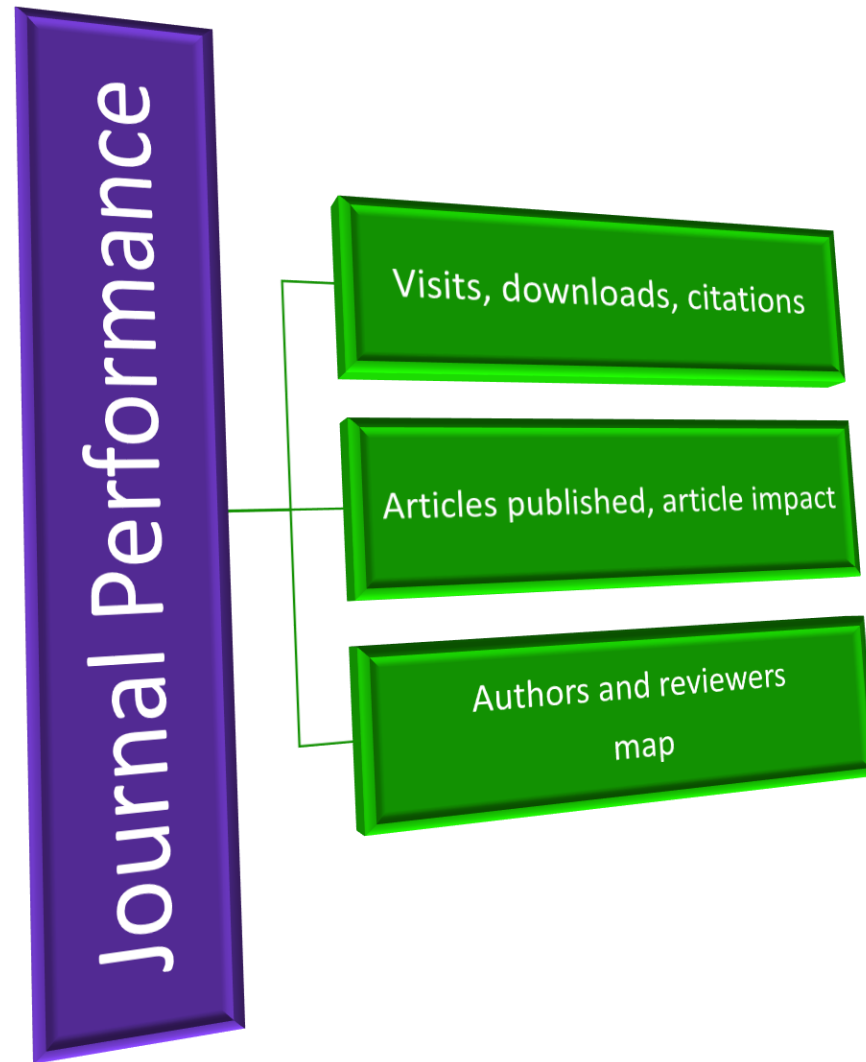
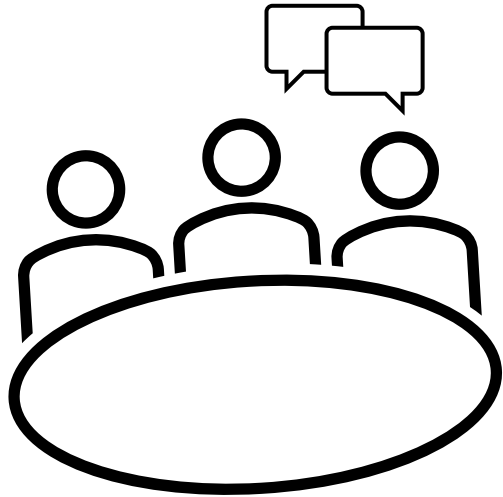
- Attracting other **authors from different geographies**

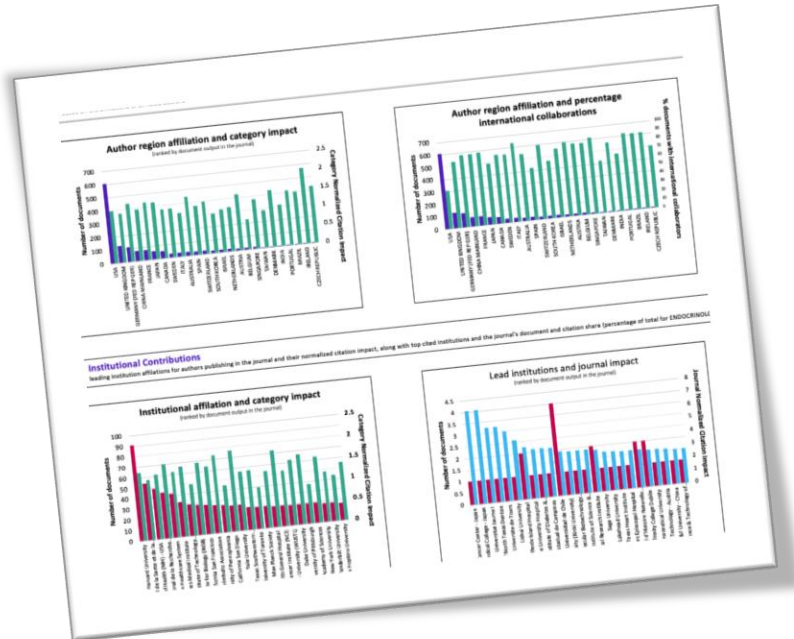

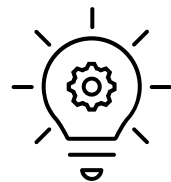

The outcome



- The top 5 journals in the category publish the most cited articles
- The citation share of documents by authors from Europe is as high as for those in the USA
- Only 4 in 10 European authors publish in the top 5 journals
- 8 in 10 European authors are supported by funders with an OA mandate
- The top funders are CNRS (France). Ministry of Education (Sweden) and the European Union

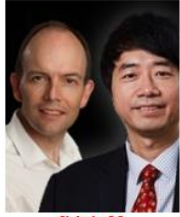

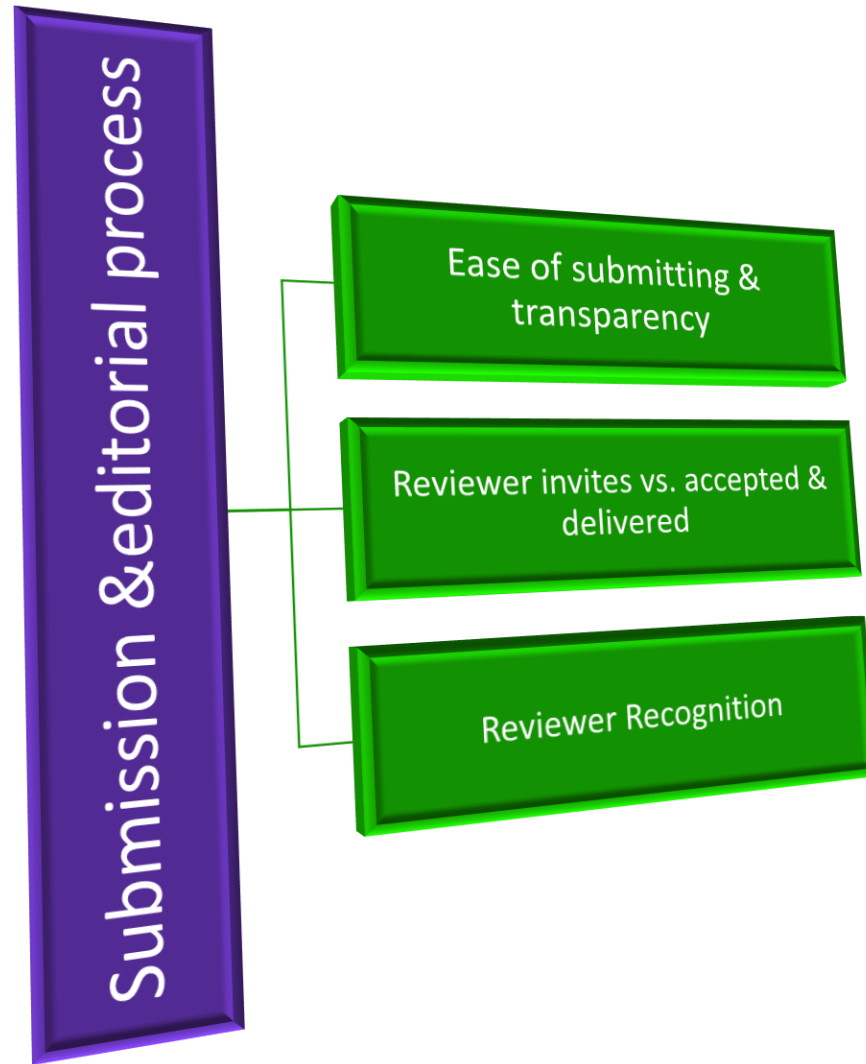

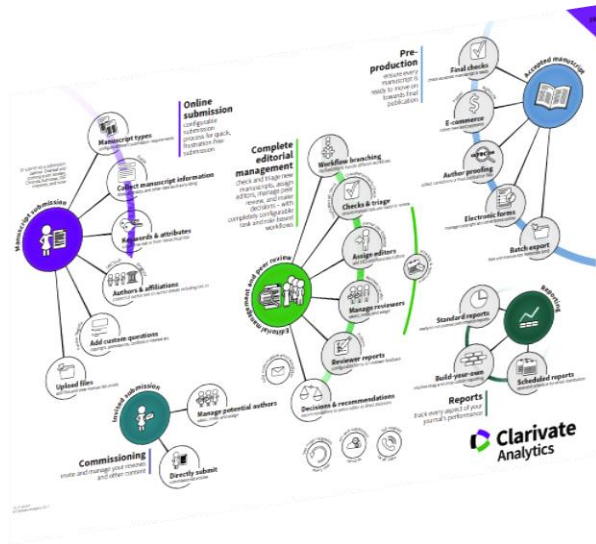
Author based in Germany, affiliated with Munster University; has published 20 articles in the past 5 years, funded by the EU and has an H-index of 7



The editorial meeting - continued



The outcome



- Submission process is too complicated and takes time
- 4 in 5 authors need help with their submission or never finalise it
- 7 in 9 reviewer invitations remain unanswered
- 9 in 10 reviewers do not finish the review on time
- 6 in 10 reviewers complain about not receiving the email with the acknowledgment of the review
- Accepted paper still requires a lot of manual work to make it ready for production

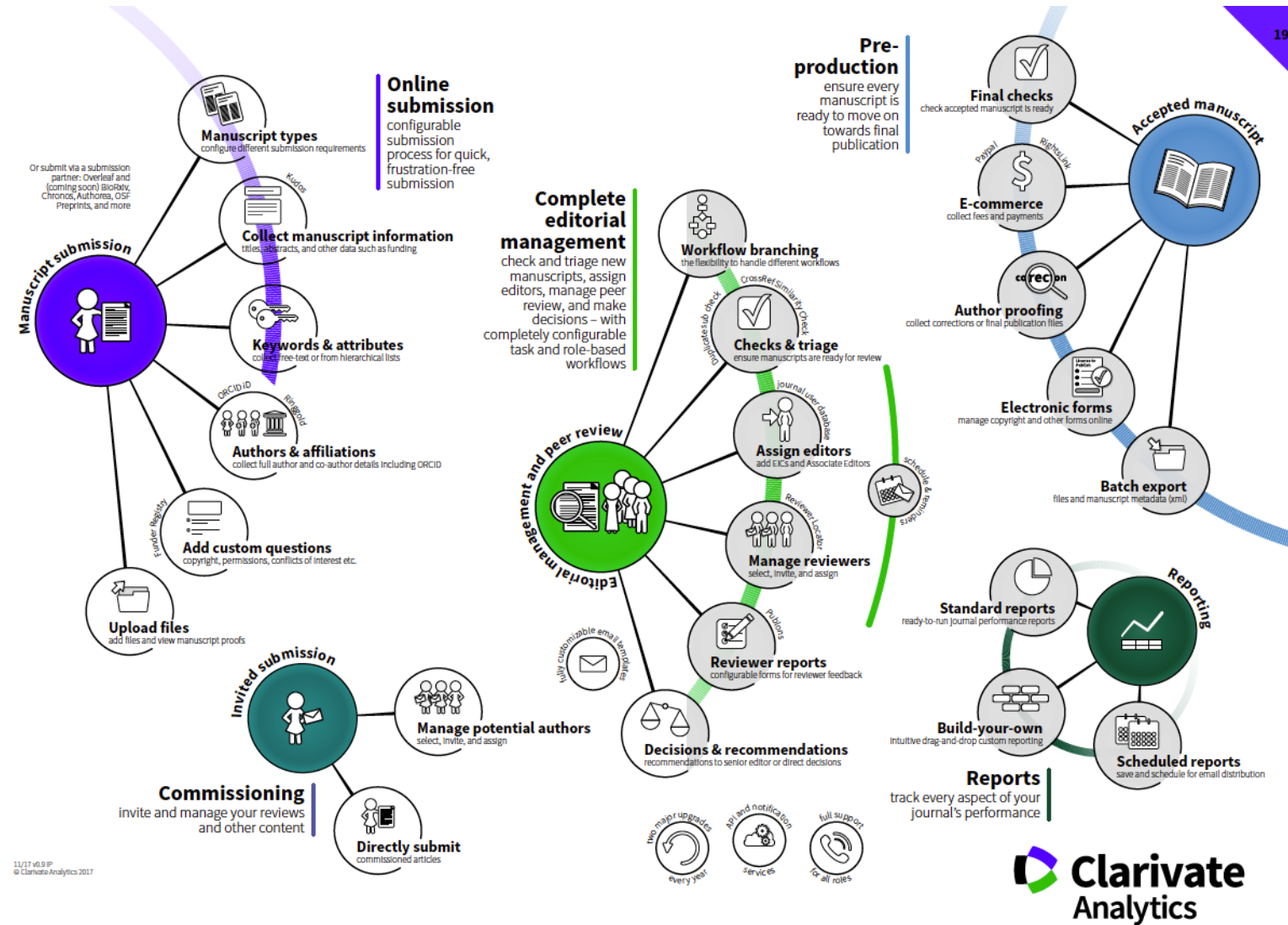

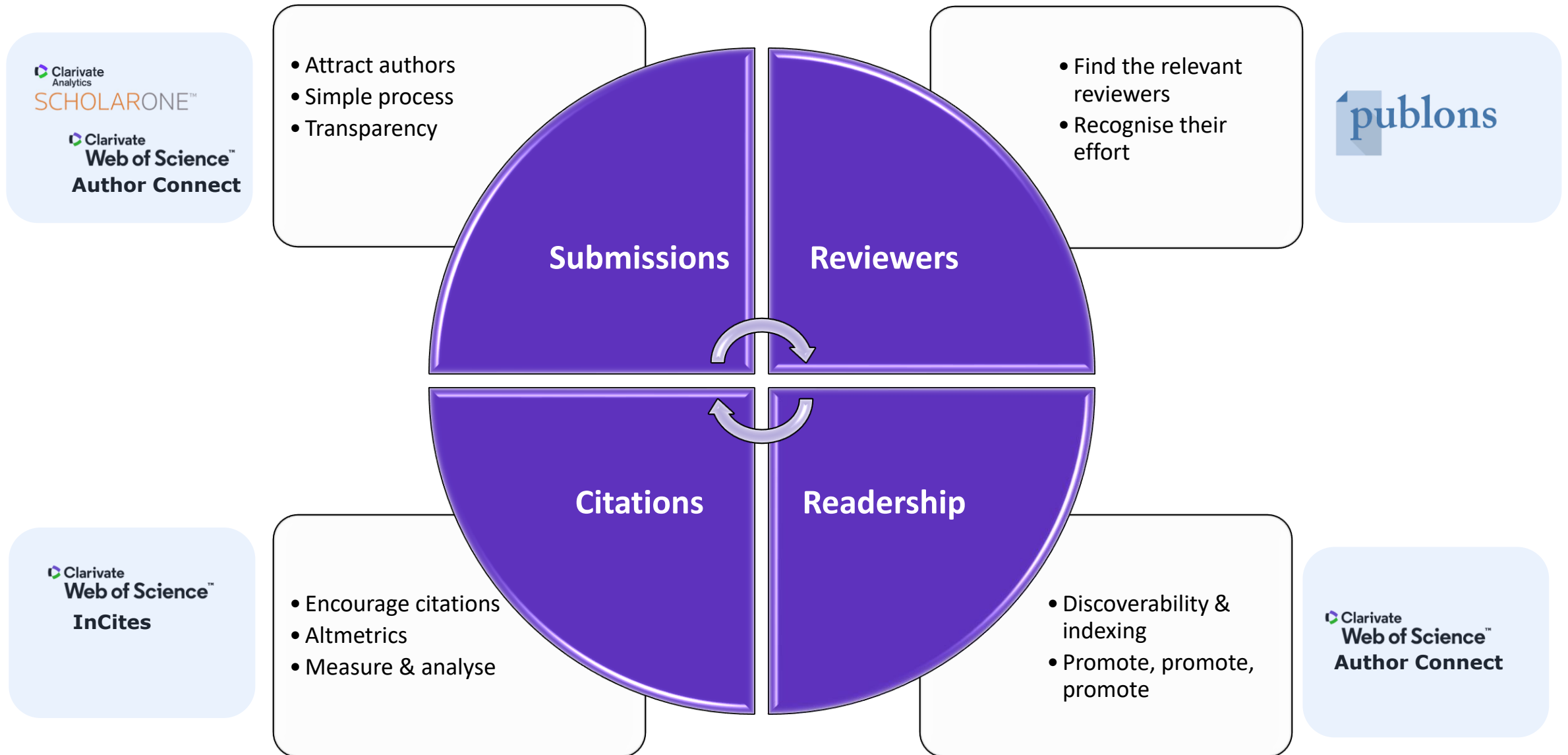
