Description of the Programme and Activities	The "Excellence Initiative – Research University" (IDUB) is a programme of the minister responsible for higher education and science, which gives the University of Warsaw opportunities for raising the quality of its academic research and education, thereby increasing the international recognition of the University.
	The recruited person will perform their duties in Action II.3.3. "Development of an expert-research centre in UW Białowieża Geobotanical Station".
	The Białowieża Geobotanical Station of the University of Warsaw is a natural biological laboratory which is unique on a global scale; it is a centre for long-term scientific projects,

which are carried out to study the changes to ecosystems due to rapid, global climate changes and in the face of increasing environmental pollution. The employment of two adjuncts will strengthen the Station's team and will allow for better use of the research potential of the main research site, thus contributing to increasing the international recognition of the University of Warsaw. Terms of reference conducting scientific research in line with the research responsibilities profile of the Białowieża Geobotanical Station and a complex project: establishing cooperation with leading research groups in the field of enquiry; applying for external funds to maintain a full-time job beyond the period of funding from the "Excellence Initiative - Research University" programme; cooperation with members of the Station's research team in the field of, and obtaining external funds for their financing; active participation in the functions of the University of Warsaw, including establishing cooperation with other research groups at the University of Warsaw; publishing the results of research conducted at the Station. Candidate profile, requirements, Requirements: qualifications fulfilment of the conditions set out in the Act of July 20, 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal Of Laws of 2021, item 478 as amended) and the Statute of the University of Warsaw (Resolution No. 443 of the Senate of the University of Warsaw, of June 26, 2019, Monitor item 190); holding a doctoral degree in a scientific discipline in the field of exact and natural sciences; having outstanding scientific achievements, confirmed by publications; presenting an original idea for the research subject, in line with the research area carried out by the Station's team, and based on the Station's data and research infrastructure, with an estimate of the research costs and an indication of the source of their financing; a fluent command of written and spoken English; international experience in the research field. # Information on personal data processing

## Controller

The DPO, however, does not perform other functions, such as handling recruitment procedures, collecting recruitment documents, or providing current information on the recruitment process.

#### Purpose and legal grounds of data processing

The personal data of candidates for employment shall be processed for recruitment purposes only.

If your documents include data as included in Art. 9 section 1 of the GDPR (special categories of personal data), processing shall be possible upon your consent to processing such data<sup>4</sup>, which may take the following wording:

The University of Warsaw will also process your personal data in future recruitment processes upon your consent<sup>5</sup>, which may take the following wording:

Be advised that the revocation of your consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing of personal data, which had been completed upon consent and before its revocation.<sup>6</sup>

### **Data retention period**

Your personal data collected in this recruitment process shall be stored within the period of up to 5 years from the planned completion of the "Excellence Initiative – Research University" Programme, i.e. until 31.12.2031.

In case you agree to process your data in future recruitments, your data will be used for this purpose for a period of 9 months from the end of recruitment.

#### **Data recipients**

Officers authorized by the Controller shall have access to your personal data, the processing of which is within the scope of their duties.

## Data transfer outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

## Rights of the data subject
