Project and position description	The "Excellence Initiative – Research University" is a programme of the minister responsible for higher education and science, which enables the University of Warsaw to raise the level of its research activities, the quality of education and accordingly, the international recognition of the University.
	The project is part of the Program Initiative of Excellence: Research University and its main goal is to create an interdisciplinary and international research

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network focusing on the relationships between linguisticcultural diversity and biodiversity. The position will involve research in selected multilingual and biologically diverse areas of Mexico where at least two Indigenous languages are spoken in addition to Spanish. The goal of this research is to better understand the nature of relationships between linguistic-cultural diversity and the environment/biodiversity in contemporary Mesoamerica, with a focus on key factors favoring multilingualism and its maintenance in selected areas as well as the connection between language practices and traditional knowledge. The planned research will also involve language use in multilingual ecologies, individual multilingual competences, language prestige, attitudes and policies at the societal, community and family levels. The researcher employed will also create an individual grant proposal for external funding and/or collaborate on team grant proposals. Job responsibilities 1. Fieldwork design and carrying out fieldwork in selected multilingual hotspots in Mexico, with a clear focus on patterns of linguistic-cultural diversity, local environmental strategies supported and encoded by linguistic and cultural behaviors, resources or traditional knowledge, the stability of multilingualism in connection to specific models of economy and environmental conditions in the zones of biodiversity. 2. Analysis and interpretation of quantitative and qualitative data obtained in fieldwork 3. Preparation of individual and co-authored publications resulting from the research 4. Active participation in developing an international network related to the project as well as collaboration with Indigenous communities 5. Direct and active participation in designing, developing and submitting grant applications related to the project; Key requirements 1. MA in linguistics and at least 5 years of research experience is required; 2. PhD degree in linguistics or close to completion PhD or very advanced level of development of PhD dissertation; especially welcome are applicants whose dissertation is in sociolinguistics, applied linguistics, environmental linguistics, or anthropological linguistics;

	 Strong scientific record documented in publications in high-impact international journals and editorials; Documented extensive field experience in Indigenous communities; fieldwork experience in Mexico is particularly relevant; Knowledge of qualitative and quantitative methods of research and data analysis; Knowledge of colonial Nahuatl and very good practical knowledge of one or more variants of modern Nahuatl or another major Indigenous language spoken in Mexico; knowledge of other Indigenous languages will be an asset; Ability to design and implement original research; Experience of working in an international environment/in international collaboration; Documented interdisciplinary research experience; Proficiency in spoken and written English and Spanish (at least C1/advanced level); Documented engagement and experience in language revitalization, decolonizing research and/or community-based activities will be a strong asset; Experience of long-term collaboration with Indigenous communities will be a strong asset.

Purpose and legal grounds of data processing

In case you agree to process your data in future recruitments, your data will be used for this purpose for a period of 9 months from the end of recruitment.

Data recipients

Data transfer outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

Your personal data shall be disclosed to subjects authorized by law. Signing-in is through Google Forms.
